The Teller County Public Health folks are still advising us seniors to continue with "Safe at Home" procedures. Although

businesses and restaurants are beginning to open, please do not become lax in taking every precaution to protect yourself from being infected. Hope you are outside and enjoy the wonderful spring weather.

The Teller County Public Health advises that we wait until we can be assured that our population is safe in public gatherings. We have folks wanting to help our population! Please call the center if there is anything you need! Stay safe and healthy.









